Call for papers

The contribution papers will address the co-production of urban security policies and will be based on the topics of the conference programme. Contributions must follow the established format and procedure and be sent in the timeframe given.

Selected contributions will be posted on the online space reserved for conference attendees. Contribution authors will have access to that space, where they will be able to exchange with the conference participants. A selection of the best contributions will be published on the conference website.

Topics

- **Inclusive and resilient cities.** Reducing inequalities affecting vulnerable people: refugees, migrants, children, young people, seniors, LGBTI.
- **The priority of prevention.** Examples of possible topics:
 - Prevention of discrimination, hate and violence
 - Prevention of radicalisation
 - Prevention of reoffending
 - Prevention of organised crime
 - Prevention of violence against women
 - Participation in prevention programmes
- **Places and times.** Leisure areas, nightlife, transport, large events, shopping areas
- **Role of the local and regional level** in the governance of global security

Content of the contributions

Contributions must address one of the above-mentioned topics and include:

- Examples of concrete and tried and tested practices
- An evaluation of existing practices

- An analysis of some of the topics of the conference within a specific geographical context, and a diagnosis that will include proposals for future interventions aimed at improving or strengthening security.

Format of contributions

- Papers of a length of between 15,000 and 20,000 characters (spaces included) + a 3,000-character (spaces included) abstract in English
- Contributions must be written either in English, French or Spanish

Who can submit a contribution?

- Any person or group who has knowledge on or interest in the conference topics: students, researchers, experts or security practitioners at the local or regional level or from the private sector.
- Research, consultant or other groups.

Scientific Committee

The selection committee is composed of urban security experts and professionals.
